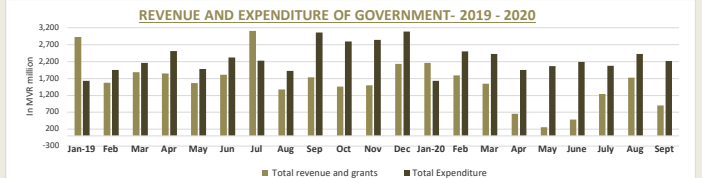
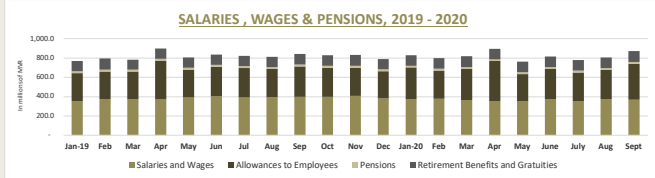
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI increased by 0.07% in Sept 2020, compared to the rise by 0.54% in Aug 2020

CPI rose at the All Group Levels in Male' by +0.05 and rose in Atolls by +0.10% in Sept 2020.

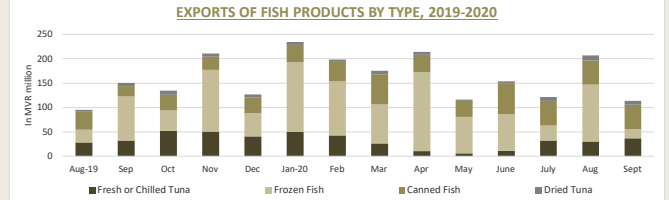
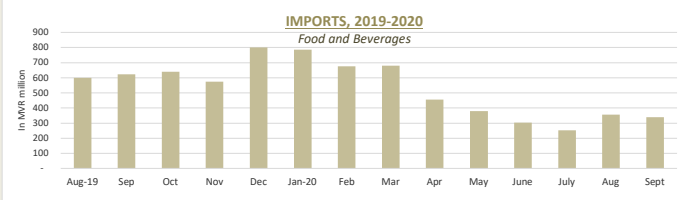
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -0.89% through the year to Sept 2020, compared to the fall of -1.20% through the year to Aug 2020.

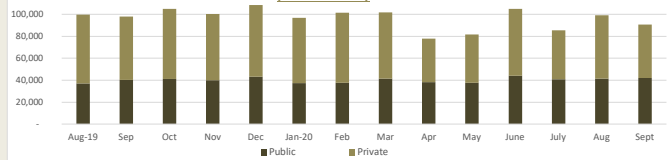

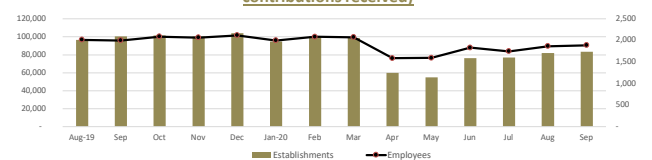

Establishments & employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)



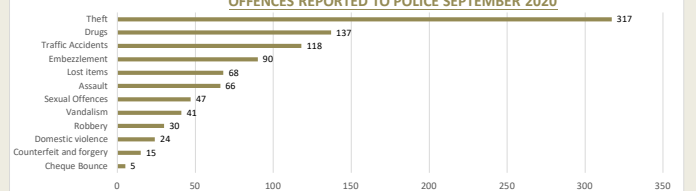

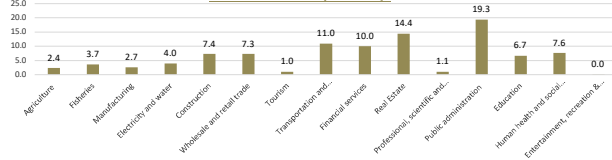

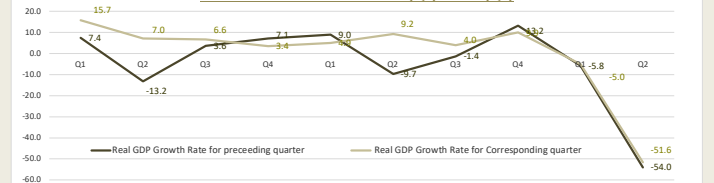
